Charles D. Michener: 80 years of scientific publications



This issue of *The Pan-Pacific Entomologist* features a paper by Natapot Warrit and Charles D. Michener (A new bee of the genus *Ceylalictus* Strand, 1913 from Thailand (Hymenoptera: Halictidae, pp. 128). Remarkably, this paper appears a full 80 years after the publication of C. D. Michener's ("Mich" to friends and family) first scientific paper, which, even more remarkably—and apparently coincidentally—also appeared in *The Pan-Pacific Entomologist* (1935, volume 11). A record of scientific publication spanning 80 years is a momentous accomplishment, and we at *The Pan-Pacific Entomologist* are honored to serve as bookends for and call attention to (despite some early reluctance by Mich!) this most notable achievement.

Mich's latest publication is the 20th (19 papers and one book review) to appear in *The Pan-Pacific Entomologist*, a complete list of which is appended below. Please join me and the rest of the Editorial Board in congratulating Mich on his 80 years of scientific publications.
